Directional particle: pila – toward

Wak vt hina pila ia tuk.

The cow went toward the road

Tvmaha pila ish ia chi ho?

Will you be going toward the town?

Word Meaning: **wak** (wahk) = cow

hina (hah-nah) = road

pila (peh-la)

vt (ah) = subject marker

ia (e-yah) = go/going

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

tvmaha (tah-ma-ha) = town

ish (esh) = you

ho (hohn) = question marker

achi (ah-chehn) = future tense marker
