Directional particle: **katimma pila** – toward which way

Ohoyo chaha mvt katimma pila ia tuk?

Which way did that tall woman go?

Katimma pila ish ia?

Which way are you going?

Word Meaning: **ia** (e-yah) = go/going

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

chaha (chah-ha) = tall **ish** (esh) = you

mvt (maht) = that/those (short form yummvt)

katimma pila (kah-tim-mah peh-la) = toward which way

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
