**Hush** *kanvli* **tuklo** *nusi* **li** **tuk**.

**Hush** *kanvli* **nanta** *ish* **ona** **chi**?

What time will you arrive there?

**Hush** *kanvli* **pokkoli** *il* **ittvfamma** **hinla**.

We can meet at 10 o'clock.

**Word Meaning:** **tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two      **li** (lih) = I

**hush** *kanvli* (ha-she kah-nahl-lih) = hour/time/o'clock

**nusi** (noh-see) = sleep      **pokkoli** (pohk-koh-lih) = ten

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker      **nanta** (nahn-tah) = what

**ona** (o-nah) = arrive there      **hinla** (hihn-la) = can/may

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker      **ish** (esh) = you

**ittvfamma** (it-tah-fahm-ma) = meet      **il** (ill) = we

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
