

Lesson of The Day

Terms for time: ninak iklṽnna - midnight

Ninak iklṽnna nusi li tuk.

I slept at midnight.

Ninak iklṽnna ona la chi.

I will arrive at midnight.

Word Meaning:

ninak iklṽnna (nih-nahk ihk-lahn-na) = midnight

nusi (noh-sih) = sleep **li** (lih) = I

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ona (o-nah) = to arrive there

chi (chehn) = future tense marker

la (lah) = I (**li** is changed to **la** to take the **a** from **achi**)
