Terms for time: **okhlilika** – dark/darkness

Aboha pvt okhlilika.

This room is dark.

Kocha yvt okhlilika.

It is dark outside.

Word Meaning:

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room

pvt (paht) = this/these (short for ilvppvt)

okhlilika (ohk-theh-lee-kah) = dark/darkness

kocha (koh-cha) = out/outside

yvt (yaht) = subject marker
