Terms for time: **shohbi** – all day (until late evening)

Holisso apisa ish antta na shohbi tuk o?

Did you stay at school all day?

Antta li shohbi tuk.

I stayed all day.

Word Meaning:

holisso apisa (hoh-lis-soh ah-pih-sah) = school

ish (esh) = you

na (nah) = till

antta (ahnt-tah) = to be temporary

shohbi (shoh-bih) = all day (until late evening)

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

o (ohn) = question marker

li (lih) = I
