

Lesson of The Day

Word Formation: okhisushi - window

Adding the suffix ‘**ushi**’ to a base word changes the meaning to ‘smaller version’ or ‘offspring.’

Example: okhissa = door + ushi = offspring → okhis**ushi** = window

Okhisushi pvt liteha.

This window is dirty.

Okhisushi kashoffi li.

I am cleaning the window.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

pvt (paht) = this/these

okhisushi (ohk-ih-soh-she) = window

liteha (lih-te-ha) = dirty

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fih) = to clean
