

# Lesson of The Day

Word Formation: nan ola – cd player/ ipod

Placing the prefix ‘**na/nan**’ before a base word means ‘the one that.....’ or ‘that which.....’

Example: **nan** + ola = sound → **nan** ola = cd player/ipod

**Colina yvt nan ola haklo.**

**Colina is listening to the ipod.**

**Kandace vt nan ola himona chompa tuk.**

**Kandace bought a new cd player.**

Word Meaning: **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**nan ola** (nahn olah) = cd player/ipod

**haklo** (hak-loh) = listen **tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**himona** (he-moh-na) = new **vt** (aht) = subject marker

**chompa** (chohm-pa) = buy/purchase

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
