Betty did not clean the table.

Chim aboha ish kashoffi tuk o?

Did you clean your room?

Word Meaning: **vt** (aht) = subject marker

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table

ish (esh) = you **kiyo** (ke-yoh) = not

kashoffi (kah-shohf-fih) = to clean

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

o (ohn) = question marker **chim** (chehm) = your

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room
