

# Lesson of The Day

## Word Formation: **holissochi** – to write

Adding the suffix ‘**chi**’ to a verb or a noun changes the meaning to ‘cause’ or ‘make.’

Example: holisso = paper + **chi** = cause or make → holisso**chi** = cause or to be put to paper or to write

**Nanta ish holissochi?**

**What are you writing?**

**Nan vnoa holissochi li.**

**I am writing a story.**

**Word Meaning: ish** (esh) = you

**nanta** (nahn-tah) = what

**holissochi** (hoh-lis-soh-che) = to write

**nan vnoa** (nan-ahn-noh-wah) = story
