

Lesson of The Day

Word Formation: **ikhv̄nachi** – to teach

Adding the suffix ‘**chi**’ to a verb or a noun changes the meaning to ‘cause’ or ‘make.’

Example: ikhv̄na = learn + **chi** = cause or make → ikhv̄na**chi** = to teach

Nanta ish ikhv̄nachi?

What are you teaching him?

Holissochi ikhv̄nachi li.

I am teaching him to write.

Word Meaning: ish (esh) = you

nanta (nahn-tah) = what **li** (lih) = I

holissochi (hoh-lis-soh-che) = to write

ikhv̄nachi (ihk-kah-nah-che) = to teach
