Word Meaning: **chim** (chehm) = your

vlla (ahl-lah) = child **sʋ** (sah) = I

yʋt (yaht) = subject marker

nʋni hokli (nah-nih hohk-lih) =

to catch fish/fishing

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

bʋnna (bahn-nah) = want/need
