**Word Formation: isht impa = eating utensils (fork, spoon)**

**isht** = instrument; with + **impa** = to eat → **isht impa** = eating utensils (fork, spoon)

**Isht impa himona chompa tuk.**

**She bought new eating utensils.**

**Isht impa himona achefa li.**

**I am washing the new eating utensils.**

**Word Meaning: li** (lih) = I

**isht impa** (esht ehm-pa) = eating utensils  
(fork, spoon)

**himona** (he-moh-na) = new

**chompa** (chohm-pa) = buy/purchase

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**achefa** (ah-che-fah) = to wash
