Um ofi yvt woha.

My dog is barking.

Word Meaning:

nashoba (na-shoh-bah) = wolf

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

woha (wo-ha) = bark/howl/bellow

um (ahm) = my

ofi (o-feh) = dog
