Vocabulary: yupi – to swim

Ulla pvt yupi bvnna.

This child wants to swim.

Ish yupa hinla ho?

Can you swim?

Word Meaning:

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

pvt (paht) = this/these

yupi (yoh-pih) = to swim

bvnna (bahn-nah) = want/need

ish (esh) = you

hinla (hihn-la) = can/may

ho (hohn) = question marker
