

# Lesson of The Day

Complex Verbs – The Suffix ‘t’: v̄p̄v̄t pisa – try to eat/taste

Note: When you have two verbs together, the first verb gets the ‘t’ suffix.

**Palv̄ska ma v̄p̄v̄t pisa li tuk.**

I tasted that bread.

**Nipi pa v̄p̄v̄t pisa.**

Try to eat this meat.

Word Meaning: **pa** (pahn) = this/these

**nipi** (nih-pih) = meat

**v̄p̄v̄t pisa** (ah-paht peh-sah) = try to eat/taste

**palv̄ska** (pa-lahs-kah) = bread

**ma** (mahn) = that/those

**li** (lih) = I    **tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

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
