

# Lesson of The Day

Complex Verbs – The Suffix ‘t’: **falamvt ia** – return/go back

Note: When you have two verbs together, the first verb gets the ‘t’ suffix.

**Tumaha falamvt ia chi.**

He will go back to town.

**Chukka falamvt ia li.**

I am going back home.

Word Meaning:

**li** (lih) = I

**tumaha** (tah-ma-ha) = town

**falamvt ia** (fa-la-maht e-yah) = return/go back

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker (*from achi*)

**chukka** (chohk-kah) = house/home

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
