Complex Verbs – The Suffix ‘t’: **falamvt vla** – return/come back

Note: When you have two verbs together, the first verb gets the ‘t’ suffix.

Jim vt falamvt vla chi ho?

Will Jim be returning?

Jim vt falamvt vla tuk.

Jim has returned.

Word Meaning: **vt** (aht) = subject marker

ho (hohn) = question marker

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

falamvt vla (fa-la-maht ah-lah) = return/come back

chi (chehn) = future tense marker (*from achi*)

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
