Vocabulary: ikhana/ithana – to know

Ohoyo chaha ma ish ithana ho?

Do you know that tall woman?

Ikhana li.

I know. (or) I know him, her, it.

Word Meaning: **ish** (esh) = you

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

chaha (chah-ha) = tall **li** (lih) = I

ma (mahn) = short form of that

ithana (ih-tah-na) = to know

ho (hohn) = question marker

ikhana (ih-kahn-na) = to know
