Anchi sukko ikbi tuk.

She made a thick quilt.

Nipi pvt sukko.

This meat is thick.

Word Meaning:

anchi (ahn-che) = quilt

sukko (sohk-koh) = thick

ikbi (ihk-bih) = make

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

nipi (nih-pih) = meat

pvt (paht) = this (short form)
