1. Set 1

Just all old, long used/worn and broken things.

2. Set 2

Q. Ome. Chia pela la hinla hō?

Okay. Can I help you?

A. Achukma. Ish toksṽlih chiyohma chī.

Good. You will work hard.

3. Set 3

Q. Isht basha ilṽppṽto/pṽto okpulo ya?

This saw is broken?

A. A, kani pila.

Yes, throw it away.

4. Set 4

Q. Ilṽppṽko/pṽko kani pila ish achi hā?

Did you say to throw this away?

A. Keyu, yṽmmṽno/mṽno sv bṽnna.

No, I want that.

5. Set 5

Q. Amba, shulush chaha shanaiya yṽmmṽto/mṽto taloha chī hō?

However, are these crooked boots remaining?

A. Kṽna kia bṽnna hinlatuk kia. lol. Kani pila!

Somebody might want them. lol. Throw them away!

6. Set 6

Q. (o)Balafoka pṽto hlipat kania chim ahwa?

Do you think this pant is too worn?

A. Hlipa kṽt ont atopa.

It's too worn.

7. Set 7

Q. Himakma nana ik chi bṽnno kṽt chim aiasha?

Do you have any more things you don't want?

A. Nan ik sv bṽnno yṽt a laua moma.

I have plenty more of things I don't want.
