Vocabulary: alota – to be full (container)

Bota aivlhto pvt alota.

This flour container is full.

Oka aivlhto mvt alota kiyo.

That water jug is not full.

Word Meaning:

oka (o-kah) = water

bota (boh-tah) = flour

kiyo (key-yoh) = not

aivlhto (eye-ahth-thoh) = container

pvt (paht) = this/these

mvt (maht) = that/those

alota (ah-loh-tah) = to be full (container)
