Vocabulary: potoli – to touch

Nanta ish potoli tuk?

What did you touch?

Ahe shua potoli li tuk.

I touched a rotten potato.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

ish (esh) = you

potoli (poh-toh-lih) = to touch

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ahe (ah-he) = potato

shua (shoh-wah) = rotten
