Pronouns: sv/si - I

Sv chunna kiyo.

I am not skinny.

Suntiash si abeka tuk.

I was sick last Sunday.

Word Meaning:

sv (sah) = I **si** (sih) = I

chunna (chohn-nah) = skinny

kiyo (key-yoh) = not

Suntiash (son-tih-ahsh) = last Sunday

abeka (ah-be-kah) = sick

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
