Pronouns: chi - you

Chi haklo li tuk.

I heard you.

Chi abeka tuk o?

Did you get sick?

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

chi (che) = you

haklo (Hahn-kloh) = heard

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

abeka (ah-be-kah) = sick

o (ohn) = question marker
