

Lesson of The Day

Pronouns: sʋ/si - me

Nick vt sʋ pisa tuk.

Nick saw me.

ʋlla mvt si apela chi.

That child will help me.

Word Meaning: **sʋ** (sah) = me

si (sih) = me **ʋlla** (ahl-lah) = child

vt (aht) = subject marker

pisa (pehn-sah) = saw

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

mvt (maht) = that/those

apela (ah-peh-lah) = help

chi (chehn) = future tense marker
