That teacher heard us (all).

Katie vt hvpi hoyo ho?

Is Katie looking for us (all).

Word Meaning: vt (aht) = subject marker
ikhvnanchi (ihk-kah-nahn-che) = teacher
mvt (maht) = that/those
hvpi (hah-pih) = us (all)
haklo (hahn-kloh) = heard
tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
hoyo (hoh-yoh) = to search/look for
