Vocabulary: talali – to place; set

Ofi im illimpa akka talali.

Set the dog food down.

Katimma ish talali tuk?

Where did you place it?

Word Meaning: **akka** (ahk-kah) = down

talali (tah-la-lih) = to place; set

katimma (kah-tihm-ma) = where

ish (esh) = you **ofi** (o-fih) = dog

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

im (ehm) = his, her, its

illimpa (ihl-lehm-pa) = food
