Vocabulary: okpulo – to be damaged; harmed

Abinili pvt okpulo.

This chair is damaged.

Pvla mvt okpulo.

That light is damaged.

Word Meaning:

abinili (ah-bih-nih-lih) = chair

pvt (paht) = this/these

okpulo (ohk-poh-loh) = to be damaged; harmed

pvla (pa-lah) = light

mvt (maht) = that/those
