Vocabulary: ᵛwᵛshli – to fry

Ahe ᵛwᵛshli tuk.

She fried potatoes.

Nanta ish ᵛwᵛshli?

What are you frying?

Word Meaning: **ish** (esh) = you

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ahe (ah-he) = potato/potatoes

ᵛwᵛshli (ah-wash-lih) = to fry

nanta (nahn-tah) = what
