Where is your cup setting?

Aiimpa talaya.

Word Meaning:

chim (chehm) = your

isht ishko (esht esh-koh) = cup/glass

yvt (yaht) = is/the

katimma (kah-tihm-ma) = where

talaya (tah-lahn-yah) = to be setting

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pa) = table
