Vocabulary: pihsa – to suddenly see

Nanta ish pihsa tuk?

What did you suddenly see?

Sinti ya pihsa li tuk.

I suddenly saw a snake.

Word Meaning: **ish** (esh) = you

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

pihsa (pih-sah) = to suddenly see

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

sinti (sihn-tih) = snake

ya (yahn) = object marker

li (lih) = I
