Vocabulary: nukshohpa – to suddenly be afraid

Nanta ish i nukshohpa tuk?

Of what were you suddenly afraid?

Ofi ya i sv nukshohpa tuk.

I was suddenly afraid of the dog.

Word Meaning: **ish** (esh) = you

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

nukshohpa (nohk-shoh-pah) = to suddenly be afraid

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ofi (o-fih) = dog **sv** (sah) = I

ya (yahn) = object marker

i (ehn) = of him, her or it

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
