Vocabulary: yanvlli – to flow, to run as water

Oka yvt yanvlli kiyo.

The water is not flowing.

Bok a oka yvt pulhki hosh yanvlli.

The water is flowing fast at the river.

Word Meaning: **oka** (o-kah) = water

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

yanvlli (yah-nahl-lih) = to flow, to run as water

kiyo (key-yoh) = not **bok** (bohk) = river

a (ahn) = object marker

pulhki (pahth-kih) = fast

hosh (hohsh) = adverb marker

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
