Vocabulary: shanaiya – to be crooked

Iti fabvssa pvt shanaiya hosh hikia.

This pole is standing crooked.

Holbvttoaba mvt shanaiya hosh takanli.

That picture is hanging crooked.

Word Meaning: **mvt** (maht) = that/those

iti fabvssa (ih-tih fah-bahs-sah) = pole

pvt (paht) = this/these

shanaiya (shah-nah-yah) = to be crooked

hosh (hohsh) = object marker

hikia (hik-kihn-yah) = stand/standing

holbvttoaba (hohl-baht-toh-bah) = picture/image

takanli (tah-kahn-lih) = to be hanging (singular)

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
