Vocabulary: fiopa – to breathe

Chitolit fiopa li tuk.

I took a deep breath.

Chitoli hosh fiopa.

He is breathing hard.

Word Meaning:

chitolit (che-toh-liht) = loudly/hard/deep

fiopa (fe-yoh-pah) = to breathe

li (lih) = I

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

chitoli (che-toh-lih) = loud/hard

hosh (hohsh) = object marker
