Katimi ho ish yokohpa?

Why did you suddenly stop?

Kaa lusa mvt yokohpa tuk.

That black car suddenly stopped.

Word Meaning: **ish** (esh) = you

katimi ho (kah-tih-mih hohn) = why

yokohpa (yoh-koh-pah) = to suddenly stop

<mark>kaa</mark> (kah) = car

<mark>lusa</mark> (loh-sah) = black

mvt (maht) = that/those

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
