Vocabulary: falahma – to return quickly

Chukka ont falahma chi.

She will go home and return quickly.

Aiitvtoba ont falahma li tuk.

I went to the store and returned quickly.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

chukka (chohk-kah) = house

ont (onht) = go and

falahma (fah-lah-mah) = to return quickly

achi (ah-chehn) = future tense marker

aiitvtoba (eye-iht-tah-toh-bah) = store

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
