Vocabulary: wakahya – to suddenly stand; rise

Katimi ho ish wakahya tuk?

Why did you suddenly stand?

Ofi mvt wakahya tuk.

That dog suddenly rose.

Word Meaning:

katimi ho (kah-tih-mih hohn) = why

ish (esh) = you

wakahya (wah-kah-yah) = to suddenly stand; rise

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ofi (o-fih) = dog

mvt (maht) = that/those
