Vocabulary: laksha – to sweat; sweating

Ulla pvt laksha chiyyohmi.

This child is really sweating.

Chi laksha ho?

Are you sweating?

Word Meaning:

ulla (ahl-lah) = child

pvt (paht) = this/these

laksha (lahk-shah) = to sweat; sweating

chiyyohmi (chih-yoh-mih) = very/really/quite

chi (chih) = you

ho (hohn) = question marker
