Vocabulary: yuhapa – to be loosed; loosened

**Abinili pvt yuhapa chohmi.**

This chair is kind of loose.

**Abinili yuhapa pa apoksia chi.**

He will fix this loosened chair.

Word Meaning:

**abinili** (ah-bih-nih-lih) = chair

**pvt** (paht) = this/these

**yuhapa** (yoh-ha-pah) = to be loosed; loosened

**chohmi** (choh-mih) = somewhat/kind of/sort of

**apoksia** (ah-pohk-sih-yah) = to fix

**achi** (ah-chehn) = future tense marker

**pa** (pahn) = this/these (object marker)
