Vocabulary: nanv̄bli – to swallow

**Ulla mvt nanta nanv̄bli tuk?**

What did that child swallow?

**Hika nanv̄bli tuk.**

He swallowed gum.

Word Meaning:

**v̄lla** (ahl-lah) = child

**mvt** (maht) = that/those

**nanta** (nahn-tah) = what

**nanv̄bli** (nah-nahb-lih) = to swallow

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**hika** (hik-kah) = gum
