Vocabulary: s̄vba/s̄vbai – with me

Susan vt s̄vba toks̄vla ch̄i.

Susan will be working with me.

Ohoyo tuklo m̄vt s̄vbai impa tuk.

Those two women ate with me.

Word Meaning: **vt** (aht) = subject marker

s̄vba (sah-bah) or **s̄vbai** (sah-bye) = with me

toks̄vli (tohk-sah-lih) = work

ach̄i (ah-chehn) = future tense marker

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

tuklo (tohk-loh) = two **impa** (ehm-pah) = eat

m̄vt (maht) = that/those

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
