Vocabulary: piba/pibai – with us

Lillie vt piba taloa bunna.

Lillie wants to sing with us.

Okla Chahta anumpa pibai ikhvna tuk.

They learned the Choctaw language with us.

Word Meaning: **vt** (aht) = subject marker

piba (pih-bah) or **pibai** (pih-bye) = with us

taloa (tah-loh-wah) = sing

bunna (bahn-nah) = want

okla (ohk-lah) = they/people

Chahta (Chah-tah) = Choctaw

anumpa (ahn-nohm-pah) = language

ikhvna (ihk-kah-nah) = learn

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
