Vocabulary: **nʋlli** – to swallow (pl)

Ofi mʋt illimpa lawa nʋlli tuk.

That dog swallowed a lot of food.

ʋlla pʋt hika lawa nʋlli tuk.

This child swallowed a lot of gum.

Word Meaning: **nʋlli** (nahl-lih) = to swallow (pl)

ofi (o-fih) = dog **mʋt** (maht) = that/those

illimpa (ihl-lehm-pa) = food

lawa (lahn-wah) = a lot of/many

nʋlli (nahl-lih) = to swallow (pl)

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ʋlla (ahl-lah) = child **pʋt** (paht) = this/these

hika (hik-kah) = gum
