Pronouns: sv/si - I

Ulla mvt si apela tuk.

That child helped me.

Sv chunna kiyo.

I am not skinny.

Word Meaning:

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

mvt (maht) = that/those

si (sih) = I **sv** (sah) = I

apela (ah-peh-lah) = help

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

chunna (chohn-nah) = skinny

kiyo (key-yoh) = not
