Vocabulary: vno akosh – I, the one who...initiates an action with li

**Ūno akosh tvmaha ia la chi.**

Con conversationally: **Anakosh tvmaha ia la chi.**

I am the one who will go to town.

**Ūno akosh shulush himona chompa li tuk.**

Con conversationally: **Anakosh shulush himona chompa li tuk.**

I am the one who bought new shoes.

Word Meaning:

**vno akosh** (ah-noh ah-kohsh) = the one who

Con conversationally: **anakosh** (ah-nah-kohsh)

**tvmaha** (tah-mah-ha) = town

**ia** (e-yah) = go    **la** (lah) = I    **li** (lioh) = I

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker (*from achi*)

**shulush** (shoh-lohsh) = shoe/shoes    **himona** (hih-moh-nah) = new

**chompa** (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase    **tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

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
