## Ofi mvt pishno ako piba nowa tuk.

Conversationally: Ofi mut pishnako piba nowa tuk.

We are the ones with whom that dog walked.

## Pishno ako pim anumpula chi.

Conversationally: Pishnako pim anumpula chi.

We are the ones with whom he will speak.

## Word Meaning:

**pishno ako** (pihsh-noh ah-kohn) = we/us, the ones whom

conversationally: **pishnako** (pihsh-nah-kohn)

**ofi** (o-fih) = dog mvt (maht) = that/those

**piba** (pih-bah) = with **nowa** (noh-wah) = walk

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker **pim** (pihm) = to or for us

anumpula (ah-nohm-poh-la) = talk/speak

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker ( $from \ achi$ )
