Vocabulary: pishno ako – we/us, the ones whom...an action directed toward us/we

Ofi mvt pishno ako piba nowa tuk.

Con conversationally: **Ofi mvt pishnako piba nowa tuk.**

We are the ones with whom that dog walked.

Pishno ako pim anumpula chi.

Con conversationally: **Pishnako pim anumpula chi.**

We are the ones with whom he will speak.

Word Meaning:

pishno ako (pihsh-noh ah-kohn) = we/us, the ones whom

con conversationally: **pishnako** (pihsh-nah-kohn)

ofi (o-fih) = dog

mvt (maht) = that/those

piba (pih-bah) = with

nowa (noh-wah) = walk

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

pim (pihm) = to or for us

anumpula (ah-nohm-poh-la) = talk/speak

chi (chehn) = future tense marker (*from achi*)

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
