Vocabulary: **hvpishno akosh** – we/us....all the ones who initiate an action

Hvpishno akosh iskvli pi bvnna.

Con conversationally: **Hvpishnakosh iskvli pi bvnna.**

We are the ones who want money.

Hvpishno akosh e toksvli tuk.

Con conversationally: **Hvpishnakosh e toksvli tuk.**

We are the ones who worked.

Word Meaning:

hvpishno akosh (ha-pihsh-noh ah-kosh) = we/us, the ones who initiates an action

Con conversationally: **hvpishnakosh** (ha-pish-nah-kohsh)

iskvli (es-kah-lih) = money

pi (pih) = we

bvnna (bahn-nah) = want

e (e) = we

toksvli (tohk-sah-lih) = work

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
